We are a charity that provides door-to-door transport to local residents who find it difficult to access public transport, helping them to overcome and avoid social isolation. We also provide Shopmobility services in Maidenhead and Windsor.

Many people in our area are unable to get out and about on a regular basis due to mobility issues and difficulty accessing public transport. At People to Places we are able to take people to their appointments, out shopping, to see friends and family, to church, in fact anywhere they would like to go. We also organise a series of trips to places of interest, for shopping or to enjoy a pub lunch with fellow travellers.

To be able to do this we need the help of volunteer drivers. Our drivers are all MiDAS trained by us and have a current DBS check which we organise. We already have a great team of volunteer drivers but we need more to enable us to help more people get out of their homes and to make a real difference to their lives.

Our volunteers can help us when they can whether this is during the day, in the evenings or at weekends. Volunteering at People to Places is rewarding, flexible and you will know you are making a great contribution to a local charity.
